Meeting Called to Order: 8:00 AM

Governing Board's Report

- Andy McCurdy/Heather Wright
- Heather Wright was in attendance and presented on behalf of the governing board.
 - Parents are encouraged to attend the board meetings, they are held the third Thursday of each month. Next meeting will be held 10/18 and you can log volunteer hours for attending.
 - Heather asked Mrs. Johnson to speak about the expansion of the Independent Study Program.
 - In 2016 our sponsoring school district changed from Gateway to Columbia. When the charter was applied for we applied for the K-8 charter for the on premise location but we also had the option to expand into high school.
 - The Independent Study program can be expanded both into high school as well as into other counties.
 - Material Revision was done to look at the possibility of opening a learning center in Weaverville that will be open one day a week. Long term goal would be to hire a teacher to staff that location.
 - The safety committee will be meeting to discuss the possibility of providing the ALICE training program to the RSA staff. This program provides training for handling active shooter situations. There is an expense for the program which will be discussed.

Administrator's Report

- Mrs. Wahl
 - Mrs. Wahl presented pictures of the new play structure that was installed on the playground.
 - Purple Air
 - The school has installed their own Purple Air sensor on campus, this allows the staff to monitor air quality here at school.
 - Student Led teacher conferences will be held during the month of October, this is the 2nd year that we will be participating in student led conferences for grades 4-8.
 - Local indicators for LCAP are being worked on, information will be provided to parents once completed so they can see how we met the local indicators.
 - CAASPP Scores were sent to parents, there were some that were held back and not sent with others. They are in the process of sending those scores out at this time.

Teacher's Report

- Mrs. Brown
 - Teachers were grateful for the annual donations provided by the PTC to assist with purchasing classroom supplies.
 - Teachers are very happy with the new play structure.

- The Moon Festival was held, it was a great event and there was a very large turnout.
- There will be an art show at City Hall displaying RSA student work until January 2019. There will be an additional Art Show at SCOE in November.
- Cross country is underway and the season is going great.

Treasurer's Report

- Current Balance \$80498.49
- List of expenditures:
 - Money was not spent on Parent Welcome Day or the Picnic.
 - \$800 was spent for the AR (accelerated reader) program
 - \$200 donated to assist with field trip costs for students who may not be able to afford the cost
 - \$10 gift cards for trimester Character Awards were purchased for each grade level
 - \$5 gift cards for Weekly Staff Character Awards were purchased
 - \$5500 was paid out to FT teachers, each received \$200 for classroom supplies
 - \$120 was paid out to Elective teachers, each received \$20 for classroom supplies
 - \$795 spent for software utilized for the auction

- Update on Flavored Milk
 - Parent concern raised during the May General meeting on the choice of flavored milks and lower fat content milks due to sugar content and ingredient additives.
 - Government guidelines do not allow for whole milk, so non-fat and 1% milk are being offered at this time. Flavored milk is no longer an option for students.

 - This year presented some challenges due to the smoke but also because as the school continues to grow, finding a location is becoming more challenging.
 - 129 survey responses have been received. The survey is still available if you would like to provide your feedback.

- Mrs. Wahl provided results of the survey responses that have been received up to this point.
 - Each year the campout is looked at as an educational event as well as a way for families to connect.
- Morning Parking Lot Volunteers
 - Parking lot safety continues to be a concern.
 - We have a parent who has volunteered to assist in the morning a few days a week to make sure parents are aware of where they can and cannot park as well as to ensure kids are dropped off in a safe spot.
