In 2006, The Foundation for Promoting Arts Education Board of Directors unanimously agreed to launch a capital campaign for this project. The campaign is designed in two primary phases: 1) Redding School of the Arts and 2) The Children's Arts Education Theater and Community Center. We are in the process of acquiring a \$5.4M private bond for financing part of phase 1.

We are currently in the design and permitting phase for the school facilities. Depending on fundraising, we plan on starting construction in the fall of 2007 with new school facilities ready for occupancy in fall of 2008.

Redding School of the Arts opened in August 1999 as a public charter school with 165 students in Redding, California. Today, Redding School of the Arts serves a student body of 350 with a continual waiting list of interested students. Currently housed in the Shasta Learning Center, Redding School of the Arts has outgrown its current location and seeks to build a new school and Community Theater Center within the Redding city limits.



The Foundation for Promoting Arts Education was established in 2004. The goal of the foundation is to raise money to enhance the visual and performing arts educational program, as well as the overall educational programs, for Redding School of the Arts.
